An Act to amend and reenact § 13.1-1103 of the Code of Virginia, relating to membership in a professional limited liability company.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 13.1-1103 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 13.1-1103. Who may become a member.

Two One or more individuals or professional business entities (i) duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same professional services other than those of architects, professional engineers, land surveyors or certified landscape architects, of which at least one is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render such professional services within this Commonwealth or (ii) complying with the provisions of § 13.1-1111 and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render within this Commonwealth the professional services of architects, professional engineers, land surveyors or certified landscape architects, or any combination thereof, may become members of a limited liability company for pecuniary profit under the provisions of Chapter 12 (§ 13.1-1000 et seq.) of this title, for the sole and specific purpose of rendering the same and specific professional service, subject to any laws, not inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter, which are applicable to the practice of that profession in the limited liability company form.
