CHAPTER 818

An Act for the relief of Donald L. Wright.

Approved April 2, 1997

Whereas, after 30 years of service to the Commonwealth of Virginia, Donald L. Wright retired on November 1, 1995; and

Whereas, prior to Mr. Wright's retirement, the Virginia Retirement System (VRS) calculated incorrectly Mr. Wright's monthly retirement benefit to be \$2,089.55; and

Whereas, the monthly benefit that Mr. Wright receives is \$1,821.65; and

Whereas, Mr. Wright based his decision to retire at age 58 on the incorrect calculation by the VRS and, as a result, has suffered a loss and will continue to suffer a monthly loss of \$267.90 as a result of that miscalculation; and

Whereas, Donald L. Wright has no other means of relief except by action of this body; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. That there is hereby allocated from the funds appropriated to the Virginia Retirement System the lump sum of \$37,419.00 for the relief of Donald L. Wright. This amount shall be paid by check issued by the State Treasurer on a warrant issued by the Comptroller, upon execution by Donald L. Wright of a release of all claims he may have against the Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions or their officers, employees, or agents.
