That §§ 46.2-692.1, 46.2-698. 46.2-711, 46.2-724, 46.2-725, 46.2-739, 46.2-741, 46.2-742.2, 14 46.2-743, 46.2-746.4, and 46.2-746.8 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and that 15 the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 46.2-729.1, 46.2-746.10, 46.2-748.2, 16 46.2-749.2:8, 46.2-749.2:9, 46.2-749.2:10, 46.2-749.4:1, 46.2-749.4:2, 46.2-749.6:1, 46.2-749.7:2, and 17 18 46.2-749.7:3 as follows: § 46.2-692.1. Sample license plates; fee; use. 19 20 Upon application therefor, the Commissioner may issue samples of authorized license plates currently 21 issued by the Department. Every Sample license plates may display, as requested by the applicant and 22 approved by the Commissioner, a combination of up to seven numbers or letters, when feasible. 23 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, every such license plate shall display the word 24 "SAMPLE" on its face and shall bear month and year decals marked "SAMPLE.", in a manner 25 prescribed by the Commissioner. 26 The fee for sample license plates not displaying numbers or letters requested by the applicant shall 27 be ten dollars for each license plate. The fee for sample license plates displaying numbers or letters 28 requested by the applicant shall be twenty dollars for each license plate. Sample license plates shall not 29 be valid for registration purposes and shall not be mounted or displayed on any motor vehicle. 30 § 46.2-698. Fees for farm vehicles. 31 A. The fees for registration of farm motor vehicles having gross weights of 7,500 pounds or more, 32 when such vehicles are used exclusively for farm use as defined in this section, shall be one-half of the fee per 1,000 pounds of gross weight for private carriers as calculated under the provisions of § 46.2-697 and one-half of the fee for overload permits under § 46.2-1128, but the annual registration 33 34 35 fee to be paid for each farm vehicle shall not be less than fifteen dollars. 36 B. A farm motor vehicle is used exclusively for farm use: 37 1. When owned by a person who is engaged either as an owner, renter, or operator of a farm of a 38 size reasonably requiring the use of such vehicle or vehicles and when such vehicle is: 39 a. Used in the transportation of agricultural commodities, poultry, dairy products, or livestock of the 40 farm he is working to market, or to other points for sale or processing, or when used to transport 41 materials, tools, equipment, or supplies which are to be used or consumed on the farm he is working, or 42 when used for any other transportation incidental to the regular operation of such farm; or b. Used in transporting forest products, including forest materials originating on a farm or incident to 43 44 the regular operation of a farm, to the farm he is working or transporting for any purpose forest 45 products which originate on the farm he is working; or c. Used in the transportation of farm produce, supplies, equipment, or materials to a farm not worked 46 47 by him, pursuant to a mutual cooperative agreement. 2. When the nonfarm use of such motor vehicle is limited to the personal use of the owner and his **48** 49 immediate family in attending church or school, securing medical treatment or supplies, or securing 50 other household or family necessities. 51 C. As used in this section, the term "farm" shall include one or more farms, orchards, or ranches, but 52 does not include a tree farm unless it is part of what otherwise is a farm. 53 D. The first application for registration of a vehicle under this section shall be made on forms 54 provided by the Department and shall include: 55 1. The location and acreage of each farm on which the vehicle to be registered is to be used; 2. The type of agricultural commodities, poultry, dairy products or livestock produced on such farms 56 57 and the approximate amounts produced annually; 3. A statement, signed by the vehicle's owner, that the vehicle to be registered will only be used for 58 59 one or more of the purposes specified in subsection B of this section;

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60 4. Other information required by the Department; and

61 5. The above information is not required for the renewal of a vehicle's registration under this section.

62 E. The Department shall issue appropriately designed designated license plates for those motor 63 vehicles registered under this section. The design of manner in which such license plates are designated 64 shall be at the discretion of the Commissioner.

65 F. The owner of a farm vehicle shall inform the Commissioner within 30 days or at the time of his 66 next registration renewal, whichever comes first, when such vehicle is no longer used exclusively for farm use as defined in this section, and shall pay the appropriate registration fee for the vehicle based 67 on its type of operation. It shall constitute a Class 2 misdemeanor to: (i) operate or to permit the 68 operation of any farm motor vehicle for which the fee for registration and license plates is herein 69 70 prescribed on any highway in the Commonwealth without first having paid the prescribed registration fee; or (ii) operate or permit the operation of any motor vehicle, registered under this section, for 71 72 purposes other than as provided under subsection B of this section; or (iii) operate as a for-hire vehicle.

73 G. Nothing in this section shall affect the exemptions of agricultural and horticultural vehicles under 74 §§ 46.2-664 through 46.2-670.

H. Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, vehicles licensed under this section may be used 75 76 by volunteer rescue squad members and volunteer firefighters in responding to emergency calls, in 77 reporting for regular duty, and in attending squad meetings and drills. 78

§ 46.2-711. Furnishing number and design of plates; displaying on vehicles required.

79 A. The Department shall furnish one license plate for every registered motorcycle, tractor truck, 80 semitrailer, or trailer, and two license plates for every other registered motor vehicle, except to licensed motor vehicle dealers and persons delivering unladen vehicles who shall be furnished one license plate. 81 The license plates for trailers, semitrailers, commercial vehicles, and trucks, other than license plates for 82 83 dealers, may be of such design as to prevent removal without mutilating some part of the indicia 84 forming a part of the license plate, when secured to the bracket. 85

B. The Department [shall may] issue appropriately designated license plates for:

- 86 1. Passenger-carrying vehicles for rent or hire for the transportation of passengers for private trips; 2. Taxicabs:
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- 88 3. Executive sedans as defined in § 46.2-2500;
- 89 4. Limousines as defined in § 46.2-2500;
- 90 5. Passenger-carrying vehicles operated by common carriers or restricted common carriers;
- 91 6. Property-carrying motor vehicles to applicants who operate as private carriers only;
- 92 7. Applicants who operate motor vehicles as carriers for rent or hire; and
- 93 8. Motor vehicles held for rental as defined in § 58.1-2401; and
- 94 9. Trailers and semitrailers.

95 C. The Department shall issue appropriately designated license plates for motor vehicles held for 96 rental as defined in § 58.1-2401.

97 D. No vehicles shall be operated on the highways in the Commonwealth without displaying the 98 license plates required by this chapter.

99 D. E. Pickup or panel trucks are exempt from the provisions of subsection B of this section with reference to displaying for-hire license plates when operated as a carrier for rent or hire. 100

§ 46.2-724. Operation for hire of certain vehicles registered as not-for-hire; penalty. 101

102 If a motor vehicle of over 10,000 pounds registered gross weight displaying license plates entitling it that is registered to be operated exclusively not-for-hire is operated for-hire, the licensee shall be guilty 103 104 of a traffic infraction. This penalty shall be in addition to the penalty prescribed by § 46.2-704. 105

§ 46.2-725. Special license plates, generally.

A. No series of special license plates shall be created or issued by the Commissioner or the 106 Department except as authorized in this article. No special license plates in any series not provided for 107 108 in this article and no registration decal for any such license plate shall be issued, reissued, or renewed 109 on or after July 1, 1995. However, subject to the limitations contained in subdivisions 1 and 2 of 110 subsection B of this section, the Commissioner may issue special license plates that are combinations of no more than two series of special license plates authorized in this article and currently issued by the 111 112 Department; the fee for any such combination shall be equal to the sum of the fees for the two series plus the fee for reserved numbers and letters, if applicable. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of 113 114 subsection B of this section shall not apply to special license plates that are combinations of two series of special license plates authorized in this article and currently issued by the Department if one of the 115 116 two combined designs, when feasible, incorporates or includes the international symbol of access. 117

B. Except as otherwise provided in this article:

118 1. No license plates provided for in this article shall be issued until the Commissioner receives at 119 least 350 prepaid applications therefor;. In the event that 350 or more prepaid applications have not 120 been received on or before the last day of the third year from the date the license plates were last authorized, no such license plates shall be issued unless the license plates are reauthorized by the 121

122 General Assembly. Such reauthorized license plates shall remain subject to the provisions of this article; 123 2. No additional license plates shall be issued or reissued in any series that, after five or more years 124 of issuance, has fewer than 100 active sets of plates, unless applications therefor again meet the criterion 125 of subdivision 1 of this subsection; and

126 3. The annual fee for the issuance of any license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be ten 127 dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. Applications for all special license plates issued 128 pursuant to this article shall be on forms prescribed by the Commissioner. All special license plates 129 issued pursuant to this article shall be of designs prescribed by the Commissioner and shall bear unique 130 letters and numerals, clearly distinguishable from any other license plate designs, and be readily 131 identifiable by law-enforcement personnel.

132 No other state license plates shall be required on any vehicles bearing special license plates issued 133 under the provisions of this article.

134 All fees collected by the Department under this article shall be paid by the Commissioner into the 135 state treasury and shall be set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the expenses of the 136 Department.

137 C. The provisions of this article relating to registration fees shall apply only to those vehicles 138 registered as passenger cars, motor homes, and pickup or panel trucks, as defined in § 46.2-100. All 139 other vehicle types registered with special license plates shall be subject to the appropriate special 140 license plate fees, registration fees and other fees prescribed by law for such vehicle types.

141 § 46.2-729.1. Presidential inauguration license plates.

142 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, presidential inauguration license plates duly issued by 143 the District of Columbia may be displayed on any motor vehicle duly registered and licensed in Virginia 144 in lieu of license plates assigned to that motor vehicle. Such presidential license plates shall not be 145 displayed except for the period beginning January 1 through the last day of March in the year of such 146 inauguration. 147

§ 46.2-739. Special license plates for certain disabled veterans; fees.

148 A. On receipt of an application, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to applicants who 149 are disabled veterans as defined in § 46.2-100 or unremarried surviving spouses of such disabled 150 veterans. These license plates shall be special permanent red, white, and blue license plates bearing the 151 letters "DV." The application shall be accompanied by a certification from the U.S. Veterans 152 Administration that the veteran has been so designated and that his disability is service-connected. 153 License plates issued under this subsection shall not permit the vehicles upon which they are displayed 154 to use parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities that limit or impair their ability to walk.

155 B. On receipt of an application, the Commissioner shall issue special DV disabled parking license 156 plates displaying the international symbol of access in the same size as the numbers and letters on the 157 plate and in a color that contrasts to the background to veterans who are also persons with disabilities that limit or impair their ability to walk as defined in § 46.2-100. The Commissioner shall require that 158 159 such application be accompanied by a certification from a licensed physician to that effect. Special DV 160 disabled parking license plates issued under this subsection shall authorize the vehicles upon which they 161 are displayed to use parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities that limit or impair their ability 162 to walk.

163 No annual registration fee, as prescribed in § 46.2-694, and no annual fee, as set forth in subdivision 164 3 of subsection B of § 46.2-725, shall be required for any one motor vehicle owned and used personally by any veteran, provided such vehicle displays license plates issued under this section. 165

166 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 167 plates issued under this section.

168 § 46.2-741. Special license plates for survivors of attack on Pearl Harbor; fees.

169 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged 170 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States and, while serving in the armed forces 171 of the United States, was present during the attack on the island of Oahu, Territory of Hawaii, on 172 December 7, 1941, between the hours of 7:55 a.m. and 9:45 a.m., Hawaii time, the Commissioner shall 173 issue to the applicant special license plates identifying the vehicle as registered to a Pearl Harbor 174 survivor.

175 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition 176 to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 177 issued.

178 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 179 plates issued under this section.

180 § 46.2-742.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy Cross, the Distinguished Service 181 Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross.

182 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Navy HB1592EH1

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183 Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross, the 184 Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

185 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 186 plates issued under this section.

187 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 188 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 189

§ 46.2-743. Special license plates for certain veterans.

190 A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the 191 192 applicant special license plates.

193 B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an active duty or retired 194 member of the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to 195 the applicant special license plates whose design incorporates an emblem of the military service of which the applicant is an active duty or retired member. 196

197 C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II, 198 the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II.

199 D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean 200 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.

201 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam 202 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.

203 F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation 204 Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans 205 of those military operations.

206 F G. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 207 plates issued under subsection A, C, D, or E of this section. 208

§ 46.2-746.4. Special license plates for members of certain military veterans' organizations.

209 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of any of the 210 following military veterans' organizations, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the 211 members of the following organizations: the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, the 212 Marine Corps League, the First Marine Division Association, the Retired Officers Association, the 213 Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Vietnam Veterans of America. 214

§ 46.2-746.8. Special license plates for members of certain occupational associations.

215 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of such organization, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the following 216 organizations: the Communications Workers of America, the Virginia Sheriffs' Association, the Fraternal 217 218 Order of Police, the International Association of Firefighters, the Virginia State Firefighters Association, 219 the State Fire Chiefs Association of Virginia, the Association of Realtors, and the Society of Certified 220 Public Accountants.

§ 46.2-746.10. Special license plates for supporters of the AFL-CIO.

222 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 223 supporters of the AFL-CIO.

§ 46.2-748.2. Special license plates; Virginia Scuba Diver.

225 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license 226 plates bearing the legend: VIRGINIA SCUBA DIVER.

227 § 46.2-749.2:8. Special license plates for supporters of the Virginia's Western Highlands Travel 228 Council.

229 On receipt of an application, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to supporters of the 230 Virginia's Western Highlands Travel Council.

§ 46.2-749.2:9. Special license plates for supporters of the Virginia Drug Abuse Resistance 231 232 Education Association (D.A.R.E.), Inc.; fees.

233 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 234 shall issue special license plates to supporters of the Virginia Drug Abuse Resistance Education 235 Association (D.A.R.E.), Inc.

236 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 237 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 238 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and 239 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Virginia Drug Abuse Resistance Education 240 Association (D.A.R.E.), Inc., Fund, established within the Department of Accounts, for use by the 241 Virginia Drug Abuse Resistance Education Association (D.A.R.E.), Inc., in support of its activities and 242 programs.

243 § 46.2-749.2:10. Special license plates for supporters of community traffic safety programs in the 244 Commonwealth; fees.

245 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 246 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: DRIVE SMART.

247 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 248 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 249 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and 250 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Traffic Safety Fund, established within the 251 Department of Accounts, for use by the Department of Motor Vehicles to support community traffic 252 safety programs in the Commonwealth. 253

§ 46.2-749.4:1. Special license plates for Historic Yorktown; fees.

254 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 255 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: HISTORIC YORKTOWN.

256 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 257 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 258 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and 259 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Historic Yorktown Fund, established within the 260 Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Town of Yorktown and may be used 261 as provided by the governing body.

262 § 46.2-749.4:2. Special license plates for Gloucester County; fees.

263 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 264 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: GLOUCESTER: DAFFODIL CAPITAL 265 OF THE WORLD.

266 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 267 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 268 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and 269 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Gloucester. Daffodil Capital of the World Fund, 270 established within the Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the County of 271 Gloucester and may be used as provided by the governing body.

§ 46.2-749.6:1. Special license plates for supporters of the Washington D.C. United soccer team.

273 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 274 supporters of the Washington D.C. United soccer team.

§ 46.2-749.7:2. Special license plates; Old Dominion Boat Club. 275

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276 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license 277 plates bearing the following legend: OLD DOMINION BOAT CLUB.

278 § 46.2-749.7:3. Special license plates for supporters of Gate City High School; fees.

279 On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 280 shall issue special license plates to supporters of Gate City High School. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to the prescribed fee for state 281 282 license plates.

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
