Notwithstanding the definition for "board" as provided in § 2.1-1.2, the following entities shall be 175 referred to as boards: 176 **Compensation Board** 177 State Board of Elections 178 State Water Control Board Virginia Parole Board 179 180 Virginia Veterans Care Center Board of Trustees. 181 Article 8. 182 Virginia Geographic Information Network.

183 § 2.1-563.36. Definitions.

184 As used in this article, unless the context clearly requires a different meaning:

185 "Base map data" means the digitized common geographic data that are used by most geographic 186 information systems applications to reference or link attribute or other geographic data.

187 "Board " means the Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board.

188 "Council" means the Council on Information Management.

189 "Director" means the Director of the Council on Information Management.

190 "Division" means the Geographic Information Network Division.

"Geographic data" means data that contain either coordinates that reference a geographic location 191 192 or area or attribute data that can be related to a geographic area or location.

"Geographic information system (GIS)" means a computerized system that stores and links 193 194 geographic data to allow a wide range of information processing and display operations, as well as 195 map production, analysis, and modeling.

196 § 2.1-563.37. Geographic Information Network Division established.

There is hereby established within the Council on Information Management, a Geographic 197 198 Information Network Division, which shall foster the creative utilization of geographic information and 199 oversee the development of a catalog of GIS data available in the Commonwealth. The Division shall be 200 headed by a coordinator who shall report to the Director. The Division shall exercise the powers and 201 duties conferred in this article. 202

§ 2.1-563.38. Powers and duties of the Division; Division coordinator.

203 A. The powers and duties of the Division include:

204 1. Requesting the services, expertise, supplies and facilities of the Council from the Director on 205 issues concerning the Division.

2. Accepting grants from the United States government and agencies and instrumentalities thereof 206 207 and any other source. To those ends, the Division shall have the power to comply with such conditions 208 and execute such agreements as may be necessary or desirable.

209 3. Fixing, altering, charging, and collecting rates, rentals, and other charges for the use or sale of 210 products of, or services rendered by, the Division, at rates which reflect the fair market value.

211 4. Soliciting, receiving, and considering proposals for funding projects or initiatives from any state 212 or federal agency, local or regional government, institution of higher education, nonprofit organization, 213 or private person or corporation.

214 5. Soliciting and accepting funds, goods and in-kind services that are part of any accepted project 215 proposal.

216 6. Establishing ad hoc committees or project teams to investigate related technology or technical 217 issues and providing results and recommendations for Division action.

218 7. Establishing such bureaus, sections or units as the Division deems appropriate to carry out its 219 powers and duties. 220

B. The Division shall have a coordinator, under the supervision of the Director, who shall:

221 1. Oversee the development of and recommend to the Council the promulgation of those policies and 222 guidelines required to support state and local government exchange, acquisition, storage, use, sharing 223 and distribution of geographic or base map data and related technologies.

224 2. Foster the development of a coordinated comprehensive system for providing ready access to 225 electronic state government geographic data products for individuals, businesses, and other entities.

3. Initiate and manage projects or conduct procurement activities relating to the development or 226 227 acquisition of geographic data and /or statewide base map data. 228

4. Plan for and coordinate the development or procurement of priority geographic base map data.

229 5. Develop, maintain, and provide, in the most cost-effective manner, access to the catalog of Virginia geographic data and governmental geographic data users. 230

6. Provide, upon request, advice and guidance on all agreements and contracts from all branches of 231 232 state government for geographic data acquisition and design and the installation and maintenance of 233 geographic information systems.

234 7. Compile a data catalog consisting of descriptions of GIS coverages maintained by individual state 235 and local government agencies.

236 Nothing in this article shall be construed to require that GIS data be physically delivered to the 237 Division. All state agencies that maintain GIS data bases shall report to the Division the details of the 238 data that they develop, acquire, and maintain. This information shall be reported to the Division no later than June 30, 1998, after which each agency shall submit quarterly reports to the Division specifying all updates to existing data as well as all data development and acquisition currently in 239 240 241 progress. Data exempt from the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.1-340 et seq.) need not be 242 reported to the Division.

243 8. Identify and collect information and technical requirements to assist the Division in setting priorities for the development of state digital geographic data and base maps that meet the needs of 244

245 state agencies, institutions of higher education, and local governments.

246 9. Provide services, geographic data products and access to the repository at rates established by the
 247 Division.

248 10. Ensure the compliance of those policies, standards, and guidelines adopted by the Council
249 required to support and govern the security of state and local government exchange, acquisition,
250 storage, use, sharing, and distribution of geographic or base map data and related technologies.

251 § 2.1-563.39. GIS Fund created.

252 There is hereby created in the state treasury a special, nonreverting fund to be known as the GIS Fund, hereafter referred to as "the Fund." The Fund shall be established on the books of the 253 254 Comptroller. All moneys collected pursuant to § 2.1-563.38 A shall be paid into the state treasury and 255 credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited 256 to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall 257 not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for 258 the purposes set forth in this article. Expenditures and disbursements from the Fund shall be made by 259 the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the Comptroller upon written request signed by the Director. 260 § 2.1-563.40. Additional powers and duties of Director of the Council on Information Management.

261 The Director of the Council on Information Management shall have the power and duty, on the 262 recommendation of the Coordinator, to (i) receive and dispense funds; (ii) enter into contracts for the 263 purpose of carrying out the provisions of this article; (iii) rent office space and procure equipment, 264 goods, and services that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this article; and (iv) employ full or 265 part-time personnel and to fix their compensation.

266 § 2.1-563.41. Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board created; membership; terms;
 267 meetings; quorum.

A. The Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board (the "Board") is hereby created
 and shall advise the Division on issues related to the exercise of the Division's powers and duties.

270 B. The Board shall consist of seventeen members appointed as follows: (i) eleven members to be 271 appointed by the Governor, including: four state agency officials or their designees consisting of the 272 Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner, the Executive Director of the Economic Development 273 Partnership Authority, an agency director from one of the natural resources agencies, and one official 274 from a state university; one elected official representing a local government in the Commonwealth; one 275 member of the Virginia Association of Surveyors; one elected official who serves on a planning district 276 commission; two representatives of utilities or transportation industries utilizing geographic data; and 277 two representatives of private businesses with expertise and experience in the establishment, operation, 278 and maintenance of geographic information systems; and (ii) five members of the General Assembly, 279 three of whom shall be members of the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker of the 280 House of Delegates, and two of whom shall be members of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate 281 Committee on Privileges and Elections. The Director of the Council on Information Management shall 282 serve as an ex officio, voting member. Any members of the Board who are representatives of private businesses that provide geographic information services, and their companies, are precluded from 283 284 contracting to provide goods or services to the Division.

C. The gubernatorial appointees to the Board shall serve five-year terms, except that three initial appointees shall serve three-year terms, three shall serve four-year terms, and the remainder shall serve five-year terms. Members appointed by the Governor shall serve no more than two consecutive full terms. All members of the Board appointed by the Governor shall be confirmed by each house of the Board appointed by the coincident with their terms of office.

D. The Board shall elect from its membership a chairman, vice chairman, and any other officers
deemed necessary. The duties and terms of the officers shall be prescribed by the members. A majority
of the Board shall constitute a quorum. Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for their
services, but the nongovernmental members shall receive actual expenses in accordance with § 14.1-5.
The Board shall meet at least quarterly or at the call of its chairman or the Director.
