2 An Act to amend and reenact § 19.2-12 of the Code of Virginia, relating to conservators of the peace.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

§ 19.2-12. Who are conservators of the peace.

1. That § 19.2-12 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 Every judge throughout the Commonwealth and every magistrate within the geographical area for 9 which he is appointed or elected, shall be a conservator of the peace. In addition, every commissioner in 10 chancery, while sitting as such commissioner, and any special agent or law-enforcement officer of the United States Department of Justice, National Marine Fisheries Service of the United States Department 11 12 of Commerce, Department of Treasury, Department of Agriculture, Department of State, and Department of Interior, any inspector, law-enforcement official or police personnel of the United States Postal 13 14 Inspection Service and any United States marshal or deputy United States marshal whose duties involve the enforcement of the criminal laws of the United States, any officer of the Virginia Marine Patrol, any 15 criminal investigator of the United States Department of Labor, and any special agent of the United 16 States Naval Criminal Investigative Service shall be a conservator of the peace, while engaged in the 17 18 performance of their official duties.
