5	Whereas, Sandra E. Kuehn is an employee of the Department of Corrections in Roanoke, Virginia,
6	and is a participant in the Key Advantage Program; and
7	Whereas, the Key Advantage Program is offered to employees of the Department of Corrections and
8	other employees of the Commonwealth to provide health care coverage for those employees and their
9	families; and
10	Whereas, the Key Advantage Program is administered by Trigon Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Virginia;
11	and
12	Whereas, Mrs. Kuehn gave birth to her first child, a son, on August 30, 1996, and submitted all
13	medical bills resulting therefrom to Trigon Blue Cross/Blue Shield; and
14	Whereas, Trigon Blue Cross/Blue Shield notified Mrs. Kuehn that her son was not covered by the
15	Key Advantage Program health insurance because he was not enrolled as a beneficiary within 31 days
16	after his birth date; and Whereas Sendre E. Kuchn has no other means to obtain relief excent by action of this body, now
17	Whereas, Sandra E. Kuehn has no other means to obtain relief except by action of this body; now,
18 19	therefore, Be it expected by the Conorol Accombly of Virginia.
<b>20</b>	<b>Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:</b> <b>1.</b> § 1. That there is hereby allocated from the general fund appropriation to the Department of
20 21	Corrections the sum of \$335 for the relief of Sandra E. Kuehn. This sum shall be paid by check issued
<sup>21</sup> 22	by the State Treasurer on a warrant of the Comptroller to Sandra E. Kuehn, upon execution by her of a
