A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.695 and 58.1-3650.696, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation.

## Referred to Committee on Finance

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 58.1-3650.695 and 58.1-3650.696 as follows:
  - § 58.1-3650.695. Property of Friends of the Homeless, Inc.
- A. Friends of the Homeless, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located at 1600-25th Street in the City of Newport News, owned by Friends of the Homeless, Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
  - § 58.1-3650.696. Property of Office of Human Affairs, Inc.
- A. Office of Human Affairs, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located at 14357 Deloice Crescent in the City of Newport News, owned by Office of Human Affairs, Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
