15	Whereas, in April 1994, the State Veterinarian, on behalf of the Virginia Department of Agriculture
16	and Consumer Services, and the Area Veterinarian in charge, on behalf of the U.S. Department of
17	Agriculture, notified Allen Harman, C. W. Harman, Douglas Lane Belcher, and Ava B. Belcher that
18	they had reason to believe that cattle in their herds had contracted tuberculosis and needed to be
19	destroyed; and
20	Whereas, this body provided relief last year to Allen Harman, C. W. Harman, Douglas Lane Belcher,
20 21	and Ava B. Belcher for losses suffered in connection with having their herds destroyed in cooperation to
$\frac{21}{22}$	with the State Veterinarian; and
