7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**8 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 58.1-346.4:1 as follows:**9 *§ 58.1-346.4:1. Voluntary contributions to the Department for the Aging.*

10 *A. For taxable years beginning on and after January 1, 1997, any individual eligible to receive a tax*
11 *refund pursuant to § 58.1-309 may designate at the time of filing the return a contribution of any*
12 *amount of such refund to the Department for the Aging. Such revenues shall be used for the*
13 *enhancement of transportation services for the elderly and disabled.*

14 *B. The Tax Commissioner shall determine annually the total amount of revenue designated for the*
15 *Department for the Aging on all state income tax returns. The revenues collected pursuant to subsection*
16 *A shall be deposited into the general fund of the state treasury. The State Treasurer shall credit the*
17 *total amount collected to a special fund entitled the Transportation Services for the Elderly and*
18 *Disabled Fund. All moneys so deposited in such fund shall be used by the Department for the Aging for*
19 *the enhancement of transportation services for the elderly and disabled.*

20 *C. The Department for the Aging shall conduct an annual audit of the moneys received pursuant to*
21 *this section and shall provide an evaluation of all programs funded pursuant to this section annually to*
22 *the Secretary of Health and Human Resources.*
