ğ	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 46.2-676 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-676. Golf carts.
12	A. No person shall be required to obtain the registration certificates, license plates or decals, or to
13	pay any registration fee, for any golf cart which is not operated on or over any public highway in the
14	Commonwealth for any other purpose other than operating it across a highway from one portion of a
15	golf course to another portion thereof or to another adjacent golf course. Nor shall any person be
16	required to obtain registration certificates, license plates or decals, or to pay any fees to operate a golf
17	cart across any highway if the person driving the golf cart has with him in the vehicle a valid special
18	parking placard issued to him under § 46.2-731.
19	B. No person shall be required to obtain registration certificates, license plates or decals, or to pay
20	any registration fee to operate a golf cart along a road between his home and golf course if: (i) the trip
<b>2</b> 0 <b>2</b> 1	would not be longer than one-half mile in either direction, and (ii) the speed limit on the road is no
22	more than thirty-five miles per hour, and (iii) the driver of the vehicle is at least sixteen years old, and

25	C. No person shall be required to obtain registration certificates, license plates or decals, or to pay
23 26	any registration fee to operate a golf cart owned by the County of Halifax on the public highways if
20 27	such golf cart displays a slow-moving vehicle emblem in conformity with § 46.2-1081 and is being
28	operated on highways with speed limits of thirty-five miles per hour or less within the Town of Halifax
<b>20</b> <b>29</b>	on official business of the maintenance department of the County of Halifax by an employee of that
30	Department who is a licensed driver.
31	D. No person shall be required to obtain registration certificates, license plates or decals, or to pay
32	any registration fee, to operate a golf cart [, utility vehicle, or similar vehicle intended for off-road use
32	having no more than twenty-five horsepower, ] on any highway within the property limits of any public
33 34	or private two-year or four-year institution of higher education, provided such [ golf cart vehicle ] : (i)
35	displays a slow-moving vehicle emblem in conformity with § 46.2-1081, (ii) is being operated on
36	highways with speed limits of thirty-five miles per hour or less, and (iii) is operated by an employee of
37	the institution of higher education who is a licensed driver, on official business of such institution.

[ E. Every vehicle operated upon a highway pursuant to this section shall be operated only between sunrise and sunset unless equipped with such lights as are required in Chapter 10, Article 3 of Title
