Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 24.2-426 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 24.2-426. Voluntary cancellation of registration.

Any registered voter may cancel his registration and have his name removed from the central registration records by signing in person at the office of the general registrar an authorization for cancellation on a form prescribed by the State Board and mailing or submitting the signed form to the general registrar of his jurisdiction.
