

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to authorize the Commonwealth to convey certain property to the City of Chesapeake.*

5 Whereas, in 1954, the City of South Norfolk participated with the Commonwealth of Virginia in the  
6 construction of an armory by conveying certain real property to the Commonwealth and making various  
7 improvements to such property; and8 Whereas, the Commonwealth constructed an armory building which was used for National Guard  
9 purposes until the recent discontinuance of military activities; and10 Whereas, the armory property is now located in the City of Chesapeake, and the City is in a position  
11 to utilize the building and grounds for various beneficial public purposes; now, therefore,12 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**13 1. § 1. *That the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby authorized to convey, with the approval of the*  
14 *Governor and in form approved by the Attorney General, to the City of Chesapeake, the South Norfolk*  
15 *Armory Building and surrounding property located on Bainbridge Boulevard in the City of Chesapeake.*  
16 *The conveyance shall be on terms as agreed to by the Commonwealth and the City. The appropriate*  
17 *officials of the Commonwealth are hereby authorized to prepare, execute and deliver such deed and*  
18 *other documents as may be necessary to accomplish such conveyance.*
