| 11 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 12 | 1. That § 8.01-380 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 13 | § 8.01-380. Dismissal of action by nonsuit. |
| 14 | A. A party shall not be allowed to suffer a nonsuit as to any cause of action or claim, or any other |
| 15 | party to the proceeding, unless he does so before a motion to strike the evidence has been sustained or |
| 16 | before the jury retires from the bar or before the action has been submitted to the court for decision at |
| 17 18 | least thirty days prior to the date scheduled for trial. After a nonsuit no new proceeding on the same |
| 10 19 | cause of action or against the same party shall be had in any court other than that in which the nonsuit |
| 20 | was taken, unless that court is without jurisdiction, or not a proper venue, or other good cause is shown for proceeding in another court, or when such new proceeding is instituted in a federal court. If after a |
| ²⁰ 21 | nonsuit an improper venue is chosen, the court shall not dismiss the matter but shall transfer it to the |
| 22 | proper venue upon motion of any party. |
| $\overline{23}$ | B. Only one nonsuit may be taken to a cause of action or against the same party to the proceeding, |
| 24 | as a matter of right, although the court may allow additional nonsuits or counsel may stipulate to |
| 25 | additional nonsuits. The court may assess costs and reasonable attorney's fees incurred against the |
| 26 | nonsuiting party whenever a nonsuit is taken. The court, in the event additional nonsuits are allowed, |
| 27 | may shall assess costs and reasonable attorney's fees against the nonsuiting party if the nonsuiting party |
| 28 | does not prevail. |
| 29 | C. A party shall not be allowed to nonsuit a cause of action, without the consent of the adverse party |
| 30 | who has filed a counterclaim, cross claim or third-party claim which arises out of the same transaction |
| 31 | or occurrence as the claim of the party desiring to nonsuit unless the counterclaim, cross claim, or |

who has filed a counterclaim, cross claim or third-party claim which arises out of the same transaction or occurrence as the claim of the party desiring to nonsuit unless the counterclaim, cross claim, or 32 third-party claim can remain pending for independent adjudication by the court.
