An Act to amend and reenact § 15.1-887 of the Code of Virginia, relating to powers and jurisdiction of certain law-enforcement officers.

6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 15.1-887 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 15.1-887. Police jurisdiction over lands, buildings and structures; jurisdiction of offenses; appeals;
9 jurisdiction in certain public buildings with magistrate's offices.

10 A. Lands, buildings or structures used for any purpose defined in this article shall be under the police 11 jurisdiction of the municipal corporation for the enforcement of its regulations respecting the use or 12 occupancy thereof. All regular and special police officers of the municipal corporation shall have jurisdiction to make arrests on such land and in such buildings or structures for violations of such 13 14 regulations. The municipal court having criminal jurisdiction in the municipal corporation shall have 15 jurisdiction in all cases arising thereunder within the municipal corporation, and the county court of the county wherein the offense was committed shall have jurisdiction of such cases arising without the 16 municipal corporation. Appeals may be taken in such cases to the court of record having jurisdiction. 17

18 B. In any public building that is located in a county with a population between 56,000 and 57,000 19 adjoining a municipal corporation and that contains a magistrate's office which serves the municipal 20 corporation, the sheriff, any deputy sheriff, and any police officer of the municipal corporation shall 21 have the same powers which such sheriff, deputy sheriff or police officer would have in the municipal 22 corporation itself. The courts of the municipal corporation and the locality in which such public 23 building is located shall have concurrent jurisdiction of any offense committed against or any escape 24 from any such sheriff, deputy sheriff, or police officer in such public building, provided that the sheriff, 25 deputy sheriff, or police officer was present in the public building while in the performance of his 26 official duties. Such police powers and concurrent jurisdiction shall also apply during travel between the 27 municipal corporation and the public building by such sheriff, deputy sheriffs, and police officers while in the performance of their official duties. For purposes of this subsection, a "public building" shall 28 29 include the surrounding grounds of such building.
