10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 55-7.2 as follows:
12	§ 55-7.2. Inter vivos trusts; incorporation by reference.
13	If a revocable inter vivos trust refers to a written statement or list to distribute items of tangible
14	personal property not otherwise specifically named in the instrument, the statement or list shall be given
15	effect to the extent that it describes items of tangible personal property and their intended recipients
16	with reasonable certainty and is signed by the maker. The written statement or list may be prepared
17	before or after the execution of the trust instrument, may be altered by the maker at any time and may
18	be a writing that has no significance apart from its effect on the trust distribution. A trustee shall not be
19	liable for any distribution of tangible personal property to the apparent distributee under the revocable
20	inter vivos trust made without actual knowledge of the existence of a written statement or list, nor shall
21	he have any duty to recover property so distributed. However, a person named to receive certain
22	tangible personal property in a written statement or list which is effective under this section, may
23	recover that property, or its value if the property cannot be recovered, from an apparent distributee to
24	whom it has been distributed in an action brought for that purpose within one year after the

25 distribution. This section shall not otherwise affect the law of incorporation by reference.
