## **HOUSE BILL NO. 2775**

Offered January 20, 1997

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 15.1-364.2, relating to vacation of streets.

Patrons-McDonnell, Croshaw, Drake, Tata and Wagner; Senators: Schrock and Stolle

Referred to Committee on Counties, Cities and Towns

10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 15.1-364.2 as follows: 11 12

§ 15.1-364.2. Appointment of viewers in certain cities.

13 Notwithstanding the provisions of § 15.1-364, any city with a population greater than 350,000 may 14 by ordinance appoint three to five viewers for terms of one year to view each and every street or alley 15 proposed to be altered or vacated during the term. The notice requirements of § 15.1-431 shall be complied with for each hearing regarding discontinuance of the street or alley proposed to be altered or 16 vacated. The applicant for closure of streets or alleys in such cities that have appointed viewers 17 18 pursuant to this section shall not be required to advertise, and the governing body shall not be required to hold a separate hearing, for appointment of viewers for each specific street or alley proposed to be 19 20 altered or vacated. The applicant and the governing body of such city shall comply with all other provisions of § 15.1-364. 21
