HOUSE BILL NO. 824**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**

(Proposed by the House Committee on Conservation and Natural Resources
on December 19, 1996)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Baker)

A BILL to amend and reenact § 2.1-1.6 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 10.1-409.1, relating to designation of a Big Walker Creek as a state scenic river.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 2.1-1.6 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 10.1-409.1 as follows:

§ 2.1-1.6. State boards.

A. There shall be, in addition to such others as may be established by law, the following permanent collegial bodies affiliated with a state agency within the executive branch:

- 179 *designated to administer.*
- 180 A. *The Big Walker Creek in Giles County, from the Bland County line to the Big Walker Creek's*
- 181 *junction with the New River, a distance of approximately thirty-five and one-half miles, is hereby*
- 182 *designated a component of the Virginia Scenic River System.*

183 *B. The Department of Conservation and Recreation is designated to administer the Big Walker Creek*
184 *Scenic River.*
185 *C. The Governor, in consultation with the Director of the Giles County Board of Supervisors, shall*
186 *appoint the Big Walker Creek State Scenic River Advisory Board, which shall be composed of five area*
187 *residents, including at least one riparian landowner from within the designated section.*
