16	Amend Section 1 of Article V of the Constitution of Virginia as follows:

18	EXECUTIVE
19	Section 1. Executive power; Governor's term of office.
20	The chief executive power of the Commonwealth shall be vested in a Governor. He shall hold office
21	for a term commencing upon his inauguration on the Saturday after the second Wednesday in January,
22	next succeeding his election, and ending in the fourth year thereafter immediately upon the inauguration
23 24	of his successor. He No person shall be ineligible eligible to be elected more than two times to the same office for the term next succeeding that for which he was elected of Governor, and the Governor shall
25	be ineligible to any other office during his term of service.
