3	Memorializing Congress to pass the ISTEA Integrity Restoration Act or similar legislation embodying
4	the principles of the Surface Transportation Efficiency Program for the 21st Century (STEP 21).

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10	WHEREAS, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) of 1991 expires
11	September 30, 1997; and
12 13	WHEREAS, according to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) publication Federal Highway
13	Statistics, Virginia consistently receives a lower percentage of federal highway funding than its
14 15	percentage share of payments into the federal Highway Trust Fund; and
	WHEREAS, the upcoming reauthorization of the federal surface transportation program provides an
16	ideal opportunity to ensure that future methods of apportioning federal transportation funds are equitable
17	and fair; and
18	WHEREAS, adequate support for the National Highway System (NHS) is necessary to provide
19	consistent mobility and economic benefits for all states and the nation as a whole and to ensure that our
20	citizens are connected with those in all parts of the nation; and
21	WHEREAS, a streamlined transportation program is needed to provide flexible funding to allow
22	states and their local partners to respond to specific state and local needs; and
23 24	WHEREAS, there is a national interest to ensure an adequate level of resources for highways in
24 25	low-population large-land-area states and for highways in low-population small-land-area states in order to provide the road systems that are needed for national mobility, economic connectivity, and national

20 27	WHEREAS, the ISTEA Integrity Restoration Act, legislation which embodies the principles put forth
28	by the STEP 21 Coalition, has been introduced in both the United States Senate and the United States
29 29	House of Representatives; now, therefore, be it
30	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That prior to the expiration of
31	ISTEA, Congress be urged to enact the ISTEA Integrity Restoration Act to reauthorize the federal
32	surface transportation program. This legislation is based on the principles of the STEP 21 Coalition and
33	would significantly improve equity in the formulae, maximize flexibility for the states, and provide
34	adequate support for the National Highway System; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit copies of this resolution
to the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives,
and the members of the Virginia Congressional Delegation in order that they may be apprised of the
sense of the General Assembly in this matter.

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
