- 234567 Requesting the Virginia Tourism Corporation to study the feasibility and economic impact of building a major convention and exposition center in the Northern Virginia area.
- 8 WHEREAS, Northern Virginia is a large metropolitan area with numerous historic and cultural 9 attractions: and
- 10 WHEREAS, Virginia's overall economy depends on effective promotion of tourism in Virginia; and

11 WHEREAS, the Richmond area has derived benefits from the building of a major convention center which has enhanced portions of the downtown area and had a positive impact on that city's ability to 12 13 attract visitors; and

14 WHEREAS, Northern Virginia may benefit from a major convention and exposition center by 15 attracting and expanding business investment, promoting local, national and international trade, creating 16 entrepreneurial and employment opportunities and increasing tourism; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Virginia Tourism Corporation be requested to study the feasibility and economic impact of building a major convention 18 and exposition center in Northern Virginia. 19

20 All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Virginia Tourism Corporation, 21 upon request.

22 The Virginia Tourism Corporation is requested to undertake this study as part of its broader 23 examination of the need for the construction of major convention facilities throughout the

24 Commonwealth pursuant to House Joint Resolution No. 609 (1997), and to submit its findings and 25 recommendations as part of that study's final report.
