11	penalties for those convicted of domestic violence and improve awareness among the law-enforcement

13	WHEREAS, domestic violence may be the most common source of serious injury to women,
14	accounting for almost three times as many visits for health care as motor vehicle crashes; and
15	WHEREAS, domestic violence has devastating effects on a woman's physical and emotional
16	well-being and her ability to care for her children; and
17	WHEREAS, the first step toward unraveling the many layers of the nation's violence problem can
18 19	begin with awareness; and WHEPEAS the "Stop America's Violance Everywhere" program known as SAVE involves the
