11	WHEREAS, a native of Ethiopia, Dr. Adera received his bachelor's degree from Addis Ababa

13 14	WHEREAS, Dr. Adera has been a faculty member of Mary Washington College since 1989, where he teaches courses on short fiction, literature of resistance; and African literature; and
15	WHEREAS, Dr. Adera has been selected to receive Virginia's Outstanding Faculty Award; and
16	WHEREAS, Dr. Adera was selected from Virginia's more than 15,000 faculty currently teaching in
17	Virginia's colleges and universities; and
