SENATE BILL NO. 1074

Senate Amendments in [] — February 4, 1997

A BILL to amend and reenact § 2.1-37.5 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Judicial Inquiry and Review Commission; power to make rules.

Patrons—Williams, Norment, Quayle and Stolle

Referred to the Committee for Courts of Justice

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 2.1-37.5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 2.1-37.5. Power to make rules.

The Commission shall have the authority to make rules [and to amend the rules], not in conflict with the provisions of this chapter or of general law, to govern investigations and hearings conducted by it. The Commission shall not have the power to suspend any such rules or to waive the requirements thereof [except with the consent of all parties].
