A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 2.1-1.6, 2.1-20.4, and 9-6.25:2 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 35.2 of Title 2.1 an article numbered 8, consisting of sections numbered 2.1-563.36 through 2.1-563.40, relating to creation of the Virginia Education Network Board.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 2.1-1.6, 2.1-20.4, and 9-6.25:2 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 35.2 of Title 2.1 an article numbered 8, consisting of sections numbered 2.1-563.36 through 2.1-563.40, as follows:

§ 2.1-1.6. State boards.

A. There shall be, in addition to such others as may be established by law, the following permanent collegial bodies affiliated with a state agency within the executive branch:

283 B. Individual members of boards, commissions, committees, councils, and other similar bodies
 284 appointed at the state level and receiving compensation for their services on January 1, 1980, but who
 285 will not receive compensation under the provisions of this article, shall continue to receive compensation
 286 at the January 1, 1980, rate until such member's current term expires.

287 Article 8.

288 Virginia Education Network Board.

289 § 2.1-563.36. Virginia Education Network Board; functions; membership; terms; chairman; meetings;
 290 expenses.

291 The Virginia Education Network Board within the Council on Information Management is
 292 established. The Board shall be charged with assisting educational institutions and other appropriate
 293 public and private entities in the Commonwealth in the establishment, operation, and use of advanced
 294 telecommunications facilities and services that constitute the Virginia Education Network.

295 Notwithstanding the provisions of § 2.1-42.1, the Board shall consist of thirteen members, including
 296 the Secretary of Education, Director of the State Council of Higher Education, Superintendent of Public
 297 Instruction, Chancellor of the of the Community College System, State Librarian, Chairman of the
 298 Virginia Technology Council, Director of the Council on Information Management and Director of the
 299 Department of Information Technology. Any of the foregoing designated members may, with prior
 300 notification to the Chairman of the Virginia Education Network Board, delegate another member of his
 301 respective organization to serve in his stead. The remaining five members shall be designated by the
 302 Governor from institutions of higher education; the designations shall be recommended by the president
 303 of each institution. Of those members first designated by the Governor, two shall serve for terms of
 304 three years, two for terms of two years and one for a term of one year. Thereafter, the successors of all
 305 designated members shall be designated for a term of two years each. Vacancies other than by

306 expiration of the term shall be filled by the Governor for the unexpired term. No member shall serve
307 more than two consecutive two-year terms.

308 The Governor shall designate a member to serve as chairman, and the members may elect from their
309 number a vice-chairman and may appoint a secretary and such other officers as they deem necessary
310 and shall prescribe their duties and terms of office.

311 The Board shall meet at least annually or at the call of its chairman.

312 A quorum of the Board shall consist of seven members.

313 Board members shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses for travel and
314 subsistence incurred in performance of their duties as Board members away from their places of
315 residence. The expenses shall be paid from such funds as may be appropriated for the purpose.

316 § 2.1-563.37. General Powers.

317 The general powers of the Board are to:

318 1. Request the services, expertise, policy development and technical support of the Council on
319 Information Management from the Director on issues concerning the Virginia Education Network.

320 2. Accept grants from the United States government and agencies and instrumentalities thereof and
321 any other source. To these ends, the Board shall have the power to comply with such conditions and
322 execute such agreements as may be necessary, convenient or desirable.

323 3. Prescribe rules and promulgate regulations necessary or incidental to the performance of the
324 duties or executions of the powers conferred under this article concerning the Virginia Education
325 Network.

326 4. Do all acts necessary or convenient to carry out the purposes of this article.

327 § 2.1-563.38. Duties of Board.

328 The Board shall:

329 1. Allocate and oversee the administration of appropriations, grants, gifts, and contributions for the
330 Virginia Education Network.

331 2. Be responsible for monitoring and tracking all contractual and other relationships between the
332 Commonwealth and the various entities in the Virginia Education Network. Appropriate actions include,
333 but are not limited to:

334 a. Requiring such plans or reports and conducting such inspections and investigations as it deems
335 necessary;

336 b. Ensuring that agreements for the utilization of the Virginia Education Network are entered into
337 and determining the conditions thereof; and

338 c. Ensuring that the acquisition, production and distribution of services and facilities are available to
339 any entity in the Commonwealth meeting the prescribed criteria established by the Board.

340 3. Oversee and approve all planning relating to, and forecast the needs of and for, advanced
341 telecommunications services and facilities which relate to the Virginia Education Network within the
342 Commonwealth. Appropriate actions include, but are not limited to:

343 a. Ensuring the availability of adequate advanced telecommunications services and facilities; and

344 b. Ensuring the provision of assistance to the educational institutions and other appropriate entities
345 of the Commonwealth relating to the use of the Virginia Education Network.

346 4. Ensure that the development and use of the Virginia Education Network services and facilities are
347 coordinated. Appropriate actions include, but are not limited to:

348 a. Overseeing the network established for the purpose of interconnecting the various entities and
349 facilities within the Commonwealth;

350 b. Establishing appropriate criteria and evaluating the state of readiness of potential users of the
351 Virginia Education Network;

352 c. Establishing appropriate criteria and procedures for allocating available funds for the use of
353 potential users of the Virginia Education Network;

354 d. Recommending adoption of policies, standards and guidelines relating to technology, curriculum
355 and training to appropriate entities of the Commonwealth, including, but not limited to, the Council on
356 Information Management, the State Council of Higher Education and the Department of Education; and

357 e. Working with all local, state and federal agencies and other appropriate entities in matters
358 involving furthering the use of the Virginia Education Network.

359 § 2.1-563.39. Virginia Education Network funds.

360 Any funds appropriated to the Council on Information Management for carrying out the purposes of
361 this article shall be dispensed to:

362 1. Support the development of the Virginia Education Network within the Commonwealth.

363 2. Conduct and sponsor research into methods for improving the Virginia Education Network and the
364 uses which might result from these improvements.

365 3. Purchase appropriate advanced telecommunications services and facilities for the Commonwealth's
366 higher education institutions and for public libraries, museums and other appropriate entities.

367 4. Generally aid educational and other appropriate entities within the Commonwealth in their efforts

368 to serve the citizens of the Commonwealth.

369 § 2.1-563.40. Council support to the Board.

370 The Department of Planning and Budget, the Department of Education and the State Council of
 371 Higher Education shall, at the request of the Council on Information Management, provide
 372 administrative support to the Council and perform such other services as the Council may direct to
 373 provide services, expertise, supplies and facilities to the Board.

374 § 9-6.25:2. Policy boards, commissions and councils.

375 There shall be, in addition to such others as may be designated in accordance with § 9-6.25, the
 376 following policy boards, commissions and councils:
