11 12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.695,
13	58.1-3650.696, and 58.1-3650.697 as follows:
14 15	§ 58.1-3650.695. Property of Mosby Woods Recreation Association, Inc. A. Mosby Woods Recreation Association, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a
13 16	public park and cultural organization within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the
17	Constitution of Virginia.
18	B. Real property located at 3144 Plantation Parkway in the City of Fairfax, owned by Mosby Woods
19	Recreation Association, Inc., and used by it exclusively for public park and cultural purposes on a
20	nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local
21 22	taxation.
22 23	§ 58.1-3650.696. Property of Country Club Hills Recreation Corporation. A. Country Club Hills Recreation Corporation, a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a
23 24	public park or playground organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the
25	Constitution of Virginia.
26	B. Real property located at 3622 and 3624 Old Post Road in the City of Fairfax, owned by Country
27	Club Hills Recreation Corporation and used by it exclusively for public park or playground purposes on
28	a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from
29 30	local taxation.
30 31	§ 58.1-3650.697. Property of Fairfax Swimming Pool, Inc. A. Fairfax Swimming Pool, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a benevolent
32	organization within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
33	B. Real property located at 4200 Roberts Road and 10201 Forest Avenue in the City of Fairfax,
34	owned by Fairfax Swimming Pool, Inc., and used by it exclusively for benevolent purposes on a
35	nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local
36	taxation.
