7 1. That § 18.2-287.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 18.2-287.2. Wearing of body armor while committing a crime; penalty.

9 Any person who, while committing a crime of violence as described defined in § 18.2-288 (2) or a 10 felony violation of § 18.2-248 or subdivisions (a) 2 or 3 of § 18.2-248.1, has in his possession a firearm 11 or knife and is wearing body armor designed to diminish the effect of the impact of a bullet or 12 projectile shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony.

13 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state

14 correctional facilities. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation

15 is \$0.
