6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 63.1-86.1 as follows:**

8 *§ 63.1-86.1. Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF); purpose; administration.*

9 *There is hereby created the Virginia Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Program, hereinafter*
10 *referred to as TANF. All references in the Code of Virginia to "Aid to Dependent Children," "Aid to*
11 *Families with Dependent Children" and "AFDC" shall mean "Temporary Assistance to Needy Families"*
12 *and "TANF."*

13 *The TANF Program shall be administered by the Department of Social Services in compliance with*
14 *Titles IV-A and IV-F of the United States Social Security Act and related federal regulations (excluding*
15 *45 C.F.R. Parts 255 and 256), as such laws and regulations were in effect at the time of the enactment*
16 *of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. 104-193 on*
17 *August 22, 1996, to the extent that such laws and regulations do not conflict with (i) those sections of*
18 *P.L. 104-193 which are mandatory; (ii) waivers granted by the United States Department of Health and*
19 *Human Services to Virginia in effect as of January 1, 1997; (iii) state laws and regulations; (iv) the*
20 *State Plan For Title IV-A of the Social Security Act: Financial Assistance Aid to Families with*
21 *Dependent Children in effect as of September 30, 1996; or (v) the Title IV-F of the Social Security Act*
22 *Job Opportunities and Basic Skills Training Program State Plan in effect as of September 30, 1996.*
23 *Further, in any instance where a state law or regulation enacted pursuant to a waiver conflicts with the*
24 *terms of P.L. 104-193 or the Title IV-A or IV-F State Plans, such state law or regulation shall control.*

25 **2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.**
