Prohibited gambling activities; casino gambling. The General Assembly shall not enact any law to authorize any form of casino gambling in the Commonwealth. [Nor shall the Lottery Board authorize any form of casino gambling.] Casino

gambling shall include slot machines, banking card games, keno, and all forms of wagering games and 22
