An Act to amend and reenact § 15.2-926 of the Code of Virginia, relating to loitering and curfew violations; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 15.2-926 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 15.2-926. Prohibiting loitering; curfew for minors; penalty.

Any locality may by ordinance prohibit loitering in, upon or around any public place whether on public or private property. Any locality and may by ordinance also prohibit minors who are not attended by their parents from frequenting or being in public places whether on public or private property at such times, between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., as the governing body deems proper.

A violation of such ordinance by a minor shall be disposed of as provided in § 16.1-278.4.
