CHAPTER 865

An Act to amend and reenact § 15.2-926 of the Code of Virginia, relating to loitering and curfew violations; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 15.2-926 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 15.2-926. Prohibiting loitering; curfew for minors; penalty.

Any locality may *by ordinance* prohibit loitering in, upon or around any public place whether on public or private property. *Any locality and may by ordinance also* prohibit minors who are not attended by their parents from frequenting or being in public places whether on public or private property at such times, *between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.*, as the governing body deems proper.

A violation of such ordinance by a minor shall be disposed of as provided in § 16.1-278.4.
