A BILL to amend and reenact § 17-60 of the Code of Virginia, relating to documents recorded in deed books.

## 10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 17-60 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11

§ 17-60. Documents to be recorded in deed books.

13 All deeds, deeds of trust, deeds of release, certificates of satisfaction or certificates of partial 14 satisfaction, quitclaim deeds, homestead deeds, grants, transfers and mortgages of real estate, releases of such mortgages, powers of attorney to convey real estate, leases of real estate, notices of lis pendens and 15 16 all contracts in reference to real estate, which have been acknowledged as required by law, and certified copies of final judgments or decrees of partition affecting the title or possession of real estate, any part 17 of which is situated in the county or city in which it is sought to be recorded, and all other writings 18 relating to or affecting real estate which are authorized to be recorded, shall, unless otherwise provided, 19 20 be recorded in a book to be known as the deed book. All deeds, deeds of trust, deeds of release, 21 quitclaim deeds, grants, transfers, and mortgages of real estate or any addendum or memorandum 22 relating to any of these instruments submitted for recordation in the deed books of the appropriate office 23 of the clerk of court shall be prepared according to the requirements for deeds as set forth in §§ 55-48 24 and 55-58 and shall include the names of all grantors and grantees in the first clause of each such 25 instrument. Each instrument shall be indexed under all such names in accordance with the provisions of 26 § 17-79.

A current survey plat or current metes and bounds shall be recorded with each real estate deed of 27 28 conveyance recorded.
