6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 2.1-440.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Division of Purchases
7	and Supply; procurement of computer equipment.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 2.1-440.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 2.1-440.1. Procurement of computer equipment to be based on performance specifications.
11	Should any agency or institution elect to procure personal computers and related peripheral
12	equipment pursuant to any type of blanket purchasing arrangement under which public bodies, as
13	defined in § 11-37, may purchase such goods from any vendor following competitive procurement but
14	without the conduct of an individual procurement by or for the using agency or institution, it shall
15	establish, with the cooperation of the Department of Information Technology, performance-based
16	specifications for the selection of brand name equipment. Such performance-based specifications shall
17	include (i) vendor stability, service, and support; (ii) appropriate specifications regarding a vendor's
18	warranties, network compatibility, performance, and when available, mean time between failure ratings;
19	and (iii) a vendor's formal quality assurance program drafted in accordance with nationally or
20	internationally recognized standards. However, no certification by a private organization that the
21	personal computer meets such national or international standards shall be required. Any brand of
