Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 46.2-502 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 46.2-502. Clinic fees.

9 A. For those persons notified by the Department prior to July 1, 1995, to attend a driver 10 improvement clinic, the Commissioner shall charge a fee of fifty dollars. The Department and all businesses, organizations, governmental entities or individuals certified by the Department to provide 11 12 driver improvement clinic instruction shall may charge a fee of not to exceed seventy-five dollars, which shall include the processing fee set forth in subsection B of this section, to persons notified by the 13 Department on or after July 1, 1995, to attend a driver improvement clinic. No person shall be permitted 14 15 to attend a driver improvement clinic unless the person first pays the required attendance fee to the business, organization, governmental entity or individual providing the driver improvement clinic 16 17 instruction.

18 B. On or after July 1, 1995, All businesses, organizations, governmental entities or individuals 19 certified by the Department to provide driver improvement clinic instruction shall collect for the Department a processing fee of ten dollars from each person attending a driver improvement clinic 20 21 taught by such businesses, organizations, governmental entities or individuals. Such processing fee 22 payments shall accompany the clinic rosters submitted to the Department by such businesses, 23 organizations, governmental entities or individuals. No such processing fee, however, shall be required 24 or collected from members of volunteer rescue squads and volunteer fire departments who attend such 25 clinics in order to successfully complete training for emergency vehicle operation. All fees collected by 26 the Department under this subsection shall be paid by the Commissioner into the state treasury and shall 27 be set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the expenses of the Department.
