Traffic infractions within authority of traffic violations clerk; prepayment of local ordinances. 16 17 A. The Supreme Court shall by rule, which may from time to time be amended, supplemented or repealed, but which shall be uniform in its application throughout the Commonwealth, designate the 18 traffic infractions for which a pretrial Pretrial waiver of appearance, plea of guilty and fine payment 19 20 may be accepted. Such infractions shall not include only as authorized under this section as expressed in 21 the schedule provided under § 16.1-69.40:4 for any traffic infraction, except: 22 (a) Indictable offenses; 23 (b) Infractions resulting in an accident; 24 (c) Operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a narcotic or habit-producing drug, or permitting another person, who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or 25 a narcotic or habit-producing drug, to operate a motor vehicle owned by the defendant or in his custody 26 27 or control: 28 (d) Reckless driving; 29 (e) Leaving the scene of an accident: 30 (f) Driving while under suspension or revocation of driver's license; 31 (g) Driving without being licensed to drive. 32 (h) [Repealed.] 33 B. An appearance may be made in person or in writing by mail to a clerk of court or in person 34 before a magistrate, prior to any date fixed for trial in court. § 16.1-69.40:2. Nontraffic offenses for which prepayment authorized; schedules, fines; prepayment of 61 62 local ordinances.

63 A. The Supreme Court shall by rule, which may from time to time be amended, supplemented or 64 repealed, but which shall be uniform in its application throughout the Commonwealth, designate the 65 nontraffic offenses for which a pretrial Pretrial waiver of appearance, plea of guilty and fine payment 66 may be accepted. Such offenses shall not include only as authorized under this section as expressed in 67 the schedule provided under § 16.1-69.40:5 for any nontraffic offense, except:

- 68 1. Indictable offenses:
- 2. Class 1 or Class 2 misdemeanors; 69
- 70 3. Offenses which involve moral turpitude;
- 71 4. Any offenses involving injury to persons; 72
 - 5. Any offense punishable by incarceration or by a fine of more than \$500.

B. An appearance may be made in person or in writing by mail to a clerk of court or in person 73 before a magistrate, prior to any date fixed for trial in court. Any person so appearing may enter a 74 75 waiver of trial and plea of guilty and pay the fine established for the offense charged, with costs. He 76 shall, prior to the plea, waiver and payment, be informed of his right to stand trial and that his signature 77 to a plea of guilty will have the same force and effect as a judgment of court.

Such However, such schedule shall not be construed or interpreted so as to limit the 84 discretion of any trial judge trying individual cases at the time fixed for trial. The Rule of the Court 85 establishing the schedule shall be prominently posted in the place where the fines are paid. Fines and costs shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of this Code or any rules or regulations 86 87 promulgated thereunder.

Local ordinances fulfilling the criteria set out in subsection A of this section may be prepayable 89 in a like manner if such ordinances appear in a schedule entered by order of the local circuit courts. The 90 judges of each circuit may establish a schedule of the fines, within the limits prescribed by local 91 ordinances to be imposed for prepayment of local ordinances designating each offense specifically. Upon 92 the entry of such order it shall be forwarded within ten days to the Supreme Court of Virginia by the 93 clerk of the local circuit court. Such schedule shall not be 95 construed or interpreted so as to limit the discretion of any trial judge trying individual cases at the time 96 fixed for trial. Fines 97 and costs shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of this Code or any rules or regulations 98 promulgated thereunder. 99

§ 16.1-69.40:4. Traffic infractions and uniform fine schedule.

100 For any offense listed below, whether prescribed by the specified state statute or by a parallel local 101 ordinance adopted pursuant to the authority granted in § 46.2-1300, where such offense does not result 102 in an accident, a driver may enter a written appearance, waiver of court hearing, and plea of guilty, 103 and pay fines and costs. Court hearing may not be waived for any offense that results in an accident, even if it is listed here. For traffic offenses not listed below, a court hearing is required. Nothing in this 104 105 section affects bonding procedures for those offenses not listed below. Likewise, nothing in this section shall be construed to alter the operation of or the penalties prescribed pursuant to §§ 46.2-1220 through 106 107 46.2-1230 and §§ 46.2-1235 and 46.2-1237.

108 This schedule shall be applied uniformly throughout the Commonwealth, and a clerk or magistrate 109 shall not impose a fine different from the amounts shown here. The schedule does not restrict the fine a 110 judge may impose for an offense listed here in any case for which there is a court hearing. The descriptions of offense or infractions contained herein are for reference only and are not intended as a 111 112 legal definition of the offense or infraction cited.
