## HOUSE BILL NO. 1263

*A BILL to convey certain property of the Commonwealth to the Department of Conservation and Recreation.*

### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. *The Governor shall convey in the name of the Commonwealth, at terms to be agreed upon, in a form approved by the Attorney General, to the Department of Conservation and Recreation, the Commonwealth's interest in the State Military Reservation in Virginia Beach, also known as Camp Pendleton.*

§ 2. *The property conveyed shall be developed and operated by the Department of Conservation and Recreation as a state park.*
