A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.749 through 58.1-3650.793, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.749 through 58.1-3650.793 as follows:

§ 58.1-3650.749. *Property of Williamsburg Land Conservancy.*

A. The Williamsburg Land Conservancy, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.

B. Real property located in James City County, owned by the Williamsburg Land Conservancy and used by it exclusively for benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.

§ 58.1-3650.750. *Property of The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Lodge No. 875.*
