10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-2987.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-2987.1. Authorization to follow Emergency Medical Services Do Not Resuscitate Orders
13	(EMS-DNR Orders).
14	A. Qualified emergency medical services personnel or hospital emergency department health care
15	providers shall be authorized to follow Emergency Medical Services Do Not Resuscitate Orders
16	pertaining to qualified patients in the pre-hospital or hospital emergency department setting in
17 18	accordance with regulations promulgated by the Board of Health, if the order available to such personnel is in a form approved by the Board of Health.
10	For the purposes of this section, an Emergency Medical Services Do Not Resuscitate Order may be
20	issued for qualified patients who are individuals diagnosed to be afflicted with terminal conditions or
21	patients for whom attending physicians have issued Do Not Resuscitate Orders.
22	B. This section shall not authorize emergency medical personnel or hospital emergency department
23	health care providers to follow an Emergency Medical Services Do Not Resuscitate Order for any
24	patient who is able to, and does, express to such emergency medical services personnel or hospital
25	emergency department health care providers the desire to be resuscitated prior to cardiac or respiratory
26	arrest.
27 28	C. Nothing in this section or the definition of Emergency Medical Services Do Not Resuscitate Orders provided in § 54.1-2982 shall be construed to limit the issuance of or the authorization of
20 29	physicians and those persons designated in § 54.1-2901 to follow Do Not Resuscitate Orders other than
<b>3</b> 0	Emergency Medical Services Do Not Resuscitate Orders.
31	D. The provisions of this section shall not require any emergency services personnel to attempt to
32	resuscitate an individual after the death of such individual has been pronounced or determined in
33	accordance with § 54.1-2972.
