6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 15.2-903 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 15.2-903. Ordinances taxing and regulating "automobile graveyards" and "junkyards."

9 A. Any locality may adopt ordinances imposing license taxes upon and otherwise regulating the
10 maintenance and operation of places commonly known as automobile graveyards and junkyards and may
11 prescribe fines and other punishment for violations of such ordinances.

12 No such ordinance shall be adopted until after notice of the proposed ordinance has been published
13 once a week for two successive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the locality. The
14 ordinance need not be advertised in full, but may be advertised by reference. Every such advertisement
15 shall contain a descriptive summary of the proposed ordinance and a reference to the place or places
16 within the locality where copies of the proposed ordinance may be examined.

17 As used in this section the terms "automobile graveyard" and "junkyard" have the ~~meaning~~ meanings
18 ascribed to them in § 33.1-348.

19 B. Any county with a population *between 31,500 and 31,700, any county with a population* of at
20 least 43,000 but less than 45,700 and any county with a population of at least 18,000 but less than
21 19,000 may adopt an ordinance imposing the screening of automobile graveyards and junkyards as set
22 forth in § 33.1-348. Any such ordinance may apply to any automobile graveyard or junkyard within the
23 boundaries of such county regardless of the date on which any such automobile graveyard or junkyard
24 may have come into existence, notwithstanding the provisions of § 33.1-348.
