That § 28.2-705 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 28.2-705. License restrictions; exemption; penalty. 12 13 A. It is unlawful to: 1. Take crabs with a rake which is pulled or pushed by a boat; 14 15 2. Use a crab pot which has a mesh less than 1 1/2 inches; 3. Place food, except as may be provided for in regulations of the Commission, for adult male 16 (jimmy) crabs in a peeler pot. A peeler pot is exempt from mesh size limitations; 17 4. Use a boat when buying crabs which is also used to take or catch hard crabs with dredges, when 18 19 the Commission has limited the taking of crabs under § 28.2-713. 20 B. Any person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
