11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12 13	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 2.1-20.1:05 as follows:
	§ 2.1-20.1:05. Purchase of health insurance coverage by graduate students and their dependents.
14	A. Any full-time in state graduate student attending a public institution of higher education in the
15	Commonwealth who receives a stipend from such institution, shall be entitled, upon proper application
16	to the Department of Personnel and Training ("the Department"), to purchase health insurance coverage
17	for himself and his dependents through the health insurance plan administered by the Department
18	pursuant to § 2.1-20.1.
19	B. Applications to purchase health insurance coverage hereunder shall be made on an application
20 21	form prescribed by the Department. In addition to his application, the applicant shall provide any
21	necessary supporting documents requested by the Department. C. Upon payment of any required premiums, coverage shall be effective retroactive to the date of the
22 23	application.
23 24	D. The terms, conditions, and costs of health insurance coverage purchased hereunder shall be
24 25	subject to administration by the Department. The Department may increase the cost of coverage
26	consistent with its administration of health insurance plans under § 2.1-20.1.
27	<i>E.</i> Health insurance coverage purchased hereunder shall automatically terminate upon the
28	occurrence of any of the following: (i) the applicant's death, (ii) alternate health insurance coverage
29	being obtained by the applicant or his dependents, (iii) the applicant's withdrawal from graduate school
30	or reduction in the number of hours or credits to qualify as a full-time in state graduate student, or (iv)
31	any applicable condition outlined in the policies and procedures of the Department governing its

33 hereunder shall expire no later than one year after the applicant's date of graduation.
