

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 31 of Title 58.1 a section*  
3 *numbered 58.1-3122.2 and by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 31 of Title 58.1 a section numbered*  
4 *58.1-3172.1, relating to online public access to nonconfidential public records maintained by*  
5 *commissioners of the revenue and treasurers.*

8 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

9 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 31 of Title 58.1 a**  
10 **section numbered 58.1-3122.2 and by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 31 of Title 58.1 a section**  
11 **numbered 58.1-3172.1 as follows:**

12 *§ 58.1-3122.2. Remote access to nonconfidential public records maintained by commissioner.*

13 *The commissioner of the revenue may provide remote access, including access through the global*  
14 *information system known as the Internet, to all nonconfidential public records maintained by his office,*  
15 *subject to such limitations as may be imposed by applicable law. Any system of remote access created*  
16 *or maintained pursuant to this section shall include security measures that preclude remote access users*  
17 *from (i) obtaining any data that is required to be maintained as confidential pursuant to § 58.1-3, the*  
18 *Privacy Protection Act of 1976 (§ 2.1-377 et seq.), the Virginia Public Records Act (§ 42.1-76 et seq.),*  
19 *or other applicable law, and (ii) modifying or destroying any record or data in any manner.*

20 *§ 58.1-3172.1. Remote access to nonconfidential public records maintained by treasurer.*

21 *The treasurer may provide remote access, including access through the global information system*  
22 *known as the Internet, to all nonconfidential public records maintained by his office, subject to such*  
23 *limitations as may be imposed by applicable law. Any system of remote access created or maintained*  
24 *pursuant to this section shall include security measures that preclude remote access users from (i)*  
25 *obtaining any data that is required to be maintained as confidential pursuant to § 58.1-3, the Privacy*  
26 *Protection Act of 1976 (§ 2.1-377 et seq.), the Virginia Public Records Act (§ 42.1-76 et seq.), or other*  
27 *applicable law, and (ii) modifying or destroying any record or data in any manner.*
