17 A. Whenever payment of compensation is made to a surviving spouse for his use, or for	
18 the use of a minor child or children, the written receipt thereof of such surviving spouse sha	all acquit the

B. Whenever payment is made to any person eighteen years of age or over, the writte	
such person shall acquit the employer. If a minor shall be entitled to receive a sum amou	
22 more than \$300 \$10,000 [ in the aggregate ] as compensation for injuries, or as a distribut	
23 virtue of this title, the parent or natural guardian upon whom such minor shall be dependent	
shall be authorized and empowered to receive and give receipt for such moneys to the same	
25 guardian of the person and property of such minor duly appointed by proper court, and the	
discharge of such parent or natural guardian shall be a full and complete discharge of a	all claims or
demands of such minor thereunder.	
<b>28</b> C. Whenever any payment of over $\frac{300}{10,000}$ [ <i>in the aggregate</i> ] is due to a min incapacitated person as defined in $\frac{37}{1-134.6}$ the same shall be made to the guardian of	

incapacitated person as defined in § 37.1-134.6, the same shall be made to the guardian of the property
of such minor or the conservator of such incapacitated adult or, if there is none, to some suitable person
or corporation appointed by the circuit court as a trustee, and the receipt of such trustee shall acquit the
employer.
