A BILL to amend and reenact § 16.1-322.4 of the Code of Virginia, relating to payments for children from other counties or cities in secure detention facilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 16.1-322.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 16.1-322.4. Payments for children from other counties or cities.

Any locality or commission operating a juvenile secure detention facility may collect from any locality of this Commonwealth from which a child is placed in its facility a daily rate which does not exceed the sum total of the daily operating costs. Daily cost shall be based on *the cost of capital construction debt service less any state reimbursement and* the cost of feeding, clothing, caring for, and furnishing medicine and medical attention for such child as may be agreed upon by the governmental units involved.
