2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 29.1-700 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the definition of no wake.*

5 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**6 **1. That § 29.1-700 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

7 § 29.1-700. Definitions.

8 As used in this chapter, unless the context clearly requires a different meaning:

9 "Motorboat" means any vessel propelled by machinery whether or not the machinery is the principal
10 source of propulsion.11 "*No wake*" means operation of a motorboat at the slowest possible speed required to maintain
12 *steerage and headway*.

13 "Operate" means to navigate or otherwise control the movement of a motorboat or a vessel.

14 "Owner" means a person, other than a lien holder, having the property in or title to a motorboat. The
15 term includes a person entitled to the use or possession of a motorboat subject to an interest in another
16 person, reserved or created by agreement and securing payment of performance of an obligation, but the
17 term excludes a lessee under a lease not intended as security.18 "Vessel" means every description of watercraft, other than a seaplane on the water, used or capable
19 of being used as a means of transportation on water.20 "Waters of the Commonwealth" means any public waters within the territorial limits of the
21 Commonwealth, the adjacent marginal sea and the high seas when navigated as a part of a journey or
22 ride to or from the Virginia shore.23 **2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 1999.**
