| 13<br>14 | WHEREAS, over 27,000 Virginians are employed in the tobacco industry, and as many as 120,457 jobs are supported by tobacco-related activities; and  |
| 15       | WHEREAS, forty states have sued the tobacco industry seeking damages for smoking-related health   |
| 16       | costs, and the parties to these lawsuits are negotiating a national settlement that would require   |
| 17       | Congressional approval; and   |
| 18       | WHEREAS, any such national settlement, if approved, is expected to result in substantial changes in   |
| 19       | the tobacco industry and Virginia's tobacco economy; and  |
| 20       | WHEREAS, the interests of tobacco growers may not be adequately addressed by a proposed   |
