WHEREAS, just two years after beginning to run competitively, Rachelle Boone of Norfolk has established herself as a national-class high school sprinter; and

9 WHEREAS, running for the Atlantic Coast Track Club, Rachelle Boone garnered gold medals in
10 both the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes at the 1997 AAU Junior Olympics by posting times that were
11 both personal bests and broke club records; and

12 WHEREAS, Rachelle Boone also helped pace the 4 x 100 relay team to a silver medal at the same 13 event, held in Charlotte, North Carolina, during August 1997; and

WHEREAS, earlier, in June 1997, Rachelle Boone finished eighth at the U.S. Junior National
 Championships, a significant accomplishment itself but also a marker for her remarkable improvement
 over the summer; and

WHEREAS, Rachelle Boone attributes her rapid advancement to recognizing that her own potential
paralleled that of the country's top sprinters she competed against at national track camps to which her
Junior National performance qualified her; and

WHEREAS, buoyed by her 1997 successes, Rachelle Boone, a rising junior at Booker T. Washington
High School in Norfolk, has set a goal of making the U.S. Junior National team in 1998; now,
therefore, be it

 congratulate Rachelle Boone on her outstanding performance and extend best wishes and support in her
 quest for the Junior National team; and, be it
