6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 16.1-69.40:10f the Code of Virginia, relating to prepayment of disabled
7	parking fines.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 16.1-69.40:1of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 16.1-69.40:1. Traffic infractions within authority of traffic violations clerk; schedule of fines;
11 12	prepayment of local ordinances.
12	A. The Supreme Court shall by rule, which may from time to time be amended, supplemented or repealed, but which shall be uniform in its application throughout the Commonwealth, designate the
13	traffic infractions for which a pretrial waiver of appearance, plea of guilty and fine payment may be
15	accepted. Such designated infractions shall include violations of § 46.2-1242 or any parallel local
16	ordinance.
17	Such infractions shall not include:
18	(a) Indictable offenses;
19	(b) Infractions resulting in an accident;
20	(c) Operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a narcotic or
21	habit-producing drug, or permitting another person, who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or
22	a narcotic or habit-producing drug, to operate a motor vehicle owned by the defendant or in his custody
23	or control;
24	(d) Reckless driving;
25 26	(e) Leaving the scene of an accident; (f) Driving while under supremation of driver's licenses
20 27	(f) Driving while under suspension or revocation of driver's license;(g) Driving without being licensed to drive.
28	(b) [Repealed.]
29	B. An appearance may be made in person or in writing by mail to a clerk of court or in person
30	before a magistrate, prior to any date fixed for trial in court. Any person so appearing may enter a
31	waiver of trial and a plea of guilty and pay the fine and any civil penalties established for the offense
32	charged, with costs. He shall, prior to the plea, waiver, and payment, be informed of his right to stand
33	trial, that his signature to a plea of guilty will have the same force and effect as a judgment of court,
34	and that the record of conviction will be sent to the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles
35	or the appropriate offices of the State where he received his license to drive.
36	C. The Supreme Court, upon the recommendation of the Committee on District Courts, shall
37 38	establish a schedule, within the limits prescribed by law, of the amounts of fines and any civil penalties to be imposed, designating each infraction specifically. The schedule, which may from time to time be
39	amended, supplemented or repealed, shall be uniform in its application throughout the Commonwealth.
40	Such schedule shall not be construed or interpreted so as to limit the discretion of any trial judge trying
41	individual cases at the time fixed for trial. The rule of the Supreme Court establishing the schedule shall
42	be prominently posted in the place where the fines are paid. Fines and costs shall be paid in accordance
43	with the provisions of this Code or any rules or regulations promulgated thereunder.
44	D. Fines imposed under local traffic infraction ordinances which do not parallel provisions of state
45	law and fulfill the criteria set out in subsection A of this section may be prepayable in the manner set
46	forth in subsection B if such ordinances appear in a schedule entered by order of the local circuit courts.
47	The judges of each circuit may establish a schedule of the fines, within the limits prescribed by local
48 40	ordinances, to be imposed for prepayment of local ordinances designating each offense specifically.
49 50	Upon the entry of such order it shall be forwarded within ten days to the Supreme Court of Virginia by
50 51	the clerk of the local circuit court. The schedule, which from time to time may be amended, supplemented or repealed, shall be uniform in its application throughout the circuit. Such schedule shall
51 52	not be construed or interpreted so as to limit the discretion of any trial judge trying individual cases at
53	the time fixed for trial. This schedule shall be prominently posted in the place where fines are paid.
54	Fines and costs shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of this Code or any rules or regulations
55	promulgated thereunder.
