2 3 A BILL to amend and reenact § 53.1-32 of the Code of Virginia, relating to treatment and control of 4 5 6 7 prisoners.

10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 53.1-32 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11

§ 53.1-32. Treatment and control of prisoners; recreation; religious services.

13 A. It shall be the general purpose of the state correctional facilities to provide proper employment, 14 training and education in accordance with Chapter 18 (§ 22.1-339 et seq.) of Title 22.1 and § 53.1-32.1, medical and mental health care and treatment, discipline and control of prisoners committed or 15 16 transferred thereto. The health service program established to provide medical services to prisoners shall provide for appropriate means by which prisoners receiving nonemergency medical services may pay 17 fees based upon a portion of the cost of such services. In no event shall any prisoner be denied 18 medically necessary service due to his inability to pay. The Board shall promulgate regulations 19 20 governing such a program.

21 B. The Director shall provide a program of recreation for prisoners. The Director may establish, with 22 consultation from the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, a 23 comprehensive substance abuse treatment program which may include utilization of acupuncture and 24 other treatment modalities, and may make such program available to any prisoner requiring the services 25 provided by the program.

26 C. The Director is authorized to make arrangements for religious services for prisoners at times as he 27 may deem appropriate. The Director or his designee, who shall be a state employee, shall determine 28 who shall enter state correctional facilities to provide religious services and the time and location of 29 such services. At no time shall this responsibility be delegated by contract or memorandum of 30 understanding to any individual or group not employed by the state.
