Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 

1. That § 7.1-37 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
§ 7.1-37. Official song emeritus; official song.
A. The song "Carry Me Back to Old Virginia," by James A. Bland, set out in the House Joint Resolution 10, adopted by the General Assembly of Virginia at the Session of 1940, is declared to be the official song emeritus of the Commonwealth. B. The song "Virginia, Heaven On Earth To Me," by Constance McGhee Cost, is declared the official song of the Commonwealth.
