6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 23-9.2:3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 § 23-9.2:3. Power of governing body of public educational institution to establish rules and
9 regulations; offenses occurring on property of institution; state direct student financial assistance.10 A. In addition to the powers now enjoyed by it, the board of visitors or other governing body of
11 every educational institution shall have the power:12 1. To establish rules and regulations for the acceptance of students except that individuals who have
13 been convicted of violating the federal requirement to register for the selective service shall not be
14 eligible to receive any state direct student assistance; ~~to~~.15 2. To establish rules and regulations for the conduct of students while attending such institution; ~~and~~.16 3. To establish programs, in cooperation with the State Council of Higher Education and the Office
17 of the Attorney General, to promote compliance among students with the Commonwealth's laws relating
18 to the use of alcoholic beverages.19 4. To establish rules and regulations for the rescission or restriction of financial aid, within the
20 discretionary authority provided to the institution by federal or state law and regulations, and the
21 suspension and dismissal of students who fail or refuse to abide by such rules and regulations for the
22 conduct of students.23 ~~2.~~ 5. To establish rules and regulations for the employment of professors, teachers, instructors and all
24 other employees and provide for their dismissal for failure to abide by such rules and regulations.25 ~~3.~~ 6. To provide parking and traffic rules and regulations on property owned by such institution.26 4. 7. To establish guidelines for the initiation or induction into any social fraternity or sorority in
27 accordance with § 18.2-56.28 B. Upon receipt of an appropriate resolution of the board of visitors or other governing body of an
29 educational institution, the governing body of a political subdivision which is contiguous to the
30 institution shall enforce state statutes and local ordinances with respect to offenses occurring on the
31 property of the institution.32 The governing bodies of the public institutions of higher education shall assist the State Council of
33 Higher Education and the Virginia Student Assistance Authorities in enforcing the provisions related to
34 eligibility for financial aid.35 C. In order to improve the quality of the Commonwealth's work force and educational programs, the
36 governing bodies of the public institutions of higher education shall establish programs to seek to ensure
37 that all graduates have the technology skills necessary to compete in the 21st Century and, particularly,
38 that all students matriculating in teacher-training programs receive instruction in the effective use of
39 educational technology.
